


The reception area has hand-chiseled MDF slat panel forming an interesting backdrop. ew age offices are not just functionally-efficient and aesthetically pleasing but they are also designed following the green norms. Following a similar design philosophy Amit Maitra and Kallol Baroi of AK Enterprises have designed the 4,000 sq. ft. office for Kalpvriksh, a fashion design company; that is modern in concept with natural elements that showcases the company's consciousness towards nature.

Adding further insight on the design process, Amit says, "The client wanted a contemporary office with a distinct thematic element. So we tried to weave the design around the company name Kalpvriksh. In many areas, we have created the design around the vriksh or tree."

The reception desk designed like a log of wood, made from fibre glass along with artificial turf garden and hand chiseled MDF slat panel finished with duco paint forms an interesting backdrop. The other interesting highlights are the LED ceiling lights, informal seatings and garden benches that lend an unusual feel to the reception area.















The meeting room has a wooden drop ceiling above the table, which is symmetrical to meeting table's dimension. Laquered coloured **Saint Gobain** glass has been aesthetically used as a partition and it also serves as a writing board. In the conference room, the table is treated with natural veneer and is coated with polyester. On one of the walls, a graphical world map made of MDF board with printed vinyl adds an element of interest to the functional space.

The conference room has a unique look with graphical World Map made with MDF Board on one of the walls.



Also, the green tones of this map goes with the nature theme. Another enclosed room is the Managing Director's cabin. The highlights of this cabin are the table finished with veneer and polyester coating; and leaf motifs on the carpeted flooring and ceiling, similar to the one in the reception area.

No workplace is complete without a staff work area that is both functional and refreshing for the employees. Individual workstations have laminated partitions while lacquered glass has been used instead of a soft board. Corian is used at the edge of the workstation. Wooden ceiling finished with laminates has been used in the passage near the cabins.

In the entire office, there is a combination of grid type modular ceiling with gypsum ceiling and decorative wooden ceiling has been used in select areas. The walls of the office have been mostly painted with glossy finish. However, certain walls have texture paints and wallpapers. The flooring in the office is a combination of high-gloss double charged vitrified tiles and satin-finished vitrified tiles.

Overall, the office is contemporary and presents an informal and refreshing ambience because of the nature theme.
