AK Enterprises marks a sense of creativity to a residence in Kolkata with objet d'art bringing a smile to the decor

harles Eames once said, 'A role of a designer is of a good, thoughtful host meeting the needs of his client' fits perfectly when AK Enterprises designed this 5200 sq. ft. residence in Kolkata. Set up in the tallest towers, away from the hussle-bussle of a city's busy lifestyle, this project is a mix of modern and conventional style of living. Just like they say every house has its story, this home too is designed to do so. Decorative wallpapers and exciting backdrops formed the key features of the house. What makes it more appealing is the detailing. From wall fixtures to tiles to flooring, the décor doesn't stop smiling here. Everything indeed is a master piece. With six sections to the house, the décor is a symbol of serenity. The Buddha painting appears like a celebrated piece of ancestry right in front of the foyer. The linear geometric background mixed with wood and mirror placed behind the dining table gels well with shades of the chairs. The reflection of the large chandelier adjoins the entire space under one sheet i.e. the marble table. The colour scheme of the house is a splash of primary and secondary without making it too loud. With white being common to all, the reddish shade visual print in the room, grey and the pearl shade in the kitchen blends with the spaces. The indoors and outdoors are very well synced.





The walls are finished with wooden cover given to each of them. The imported curtains in the living room are apt. The sitting room and dining room is divided with a partition of large blocks. The see through portion along with the objects placed is a mark of objet d'art. In its own way, it specifies the idea of demarcating as well as designing. The living room is simple but yet very elegant. An ensemble of a swing and a seater across the sofa set is perfect. Making it even more relinquishing is the ample space given to each section. The kitchen is an amalgamation of tiles and flooring with a well-matched palatial caricature. The modular kitchen made with Hettich fittings and kitchen appliances from Siemens just fits the bill. The son's bedroom is supported by a heighted wooden flooring from wall to wall. The other side of the bedroom consists of a wardrobe finished with sliding glass doors and photo frames. An entertainment unit with a visual backdrop and hanging lights on one side is exemplary. The master bedroom reflects a sense of sensitivity with self-printed wallpaper in beige. The ottoman placed in front of the bed and the pair of chairs makes the room cozy. The lamp next to it keeps the room enlightened. The wooden ceiling gives an extra edge to the lighting effect. The pair of blue colour chairs in the lobby just covers the space without disturbing the rest.

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The lavatory attached to the master bedroom is luxurious with a roof framed with block print along with a light sparkling through it. The shower room finished with silver travertine imported tiles and shower panel is used from Oyster. In the era where space saving is given importance and books are digital, a library section is given special emphasis in the décor, placed right opposite the living room. Added with a display unit, a pair of king couches and an office table is unbelievable. The lamps and other objects in the house is a sign of creativity with each space well utilized to give a complete look to the entire décor. The paintings of the residence are spectacular.
